**It's time to sign up for the Northwest  
Regional Rally in Moses Lake, WA May 15<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>!!!**

This year the rally will be hosted by the Fraser Valley Explorers and the Wash-I-Bagos. The registration form can be found in your WIT Magazine (it's a generic rally registration form). If this is your first Northwest Regional Rally be sure and tell us on your registration form. This year we are paying the first nights parking for 1<sup>st</sup> timers but only if you let us know on the form. The cost for the rally is \$90 f/one coach/2 people, \$65 f/one coach/1 person, extra "persons" cost \$25/nite. Fees paid after May 1<sup>st</sup> increase \$20 per unit. Extra nights are \$15/night. There are 55 spaces with full hookups that will be \$20/night bringing your rally cost to \$105. They are on a first come registration basis and must be requested on registration form sent to treasurer, Don VanLeuven. **If you need handicap parking you must note that on the registration as our parking crew needs to know ahead of time how many spots are needed.**

There is a \$25 rally cancellation fee. Neither 2008 NWRR registrations nor rally gift certificates can be transferred to another unit. Gift certificates are for one coach, two people and any extra guests will pay \$25.

This year along with the educational seminars, social events, meals, games, etc. we are having a Craft Show. Your chapter presidents can give you the info on this. We hope there will be a lot of participation in this event.

We are still looking for some "Red Hat" ladies to volunteer to help serve one of our lunches at the rally. Please let Fran Murkowski know if you would be willing to do this.

This is also the first year for a NWRR Golf Tournament. It will be held on May 15<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00AM at the Sage Hills Golf & RV Resort. It is limited to 44 people so if you haven't registered yet you'd better check out our website @ <http://wash-i-bagos.org> for all the information and the entry form. All the information about the rally is on the website along with registration, entry and membership forms. For those of you without computers the information is in the WIT Magazine.
