

Washington State Rally

The Washington State Rally “Hands Across the Border” will be held Sept. 16-19 at the fairgrounds in Lynden, WA. An “early bird” registration will be held Wednesday afternoon.

Once again we will have our annual nine-hole golf tournament on Thursday, Sept. 16.

Your rally fee includes three nights camping, with lunch Friday and Saturday, and dinners on Friday and Saturday. Thursday evening the Peninsula WITs will have their charity project hamburger fry.

A \$30 per unit cancellation fee will be charged for all cancellations. No gift certificates can be transferred to another unit. Gift certificates are for one coach, two people and extra guests pay \$25 ea.

Handicapped parking needs must be requested on your registration form. Upon arrival please display your handicap placard in the windshield area to assist the parkers. Remember, as is the rule, chapters must arrive together to park together.
