

**WASH-I-BAGOS' RALLY COMMITTEES  
BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

**ICE CREAM SOCIAL** - After coordination with WASH-I-BAGOS officers, purchase sufficient ice cream, toppings, serving bowls, spoons, and napkins as needed to serve all rally participants. Normally, the cost is funded by a vendor (Farm & City Insurance). Submit receipts to treasurer. (Suggestions: Half gallon boxes can be cut into 10 - 12 generous servings with toppings or 8-10 oz. ice cream or sundae cups are available. Consideration of members with special dietary needs is suggested i.e., Diabetic, etc.)

From excerpts of latest committee reports: VV planned for 350 people. They purchased 40 half gallons of vanilla ice cream, both regular and French vanilla. They figured 8 servings per half gallon, and with no shows figured in due to other activities going on at the same time and no shows. They bought 2 - 64 oz. and one 48 oz containers of Hershey's chocolate syrup and 2- 48oz containers of strawberry syrup with 6 small bottles of Smuckers Butterscotch topping. They used 2 electric knives (provided by members) for cutting ice cream into 8 blocks, paper bowls, plastic spoons and plastic gloves. They had 10 half gallons left over and the servings were pretty large. They were ok on chocolate, strawberry syrups but way short on the butterscotch topping. The chapter bought out the extra ice cream so the cost for the event was under \$150.
