

**WASH-I-BAGOS' RALLY COMMITTEES
BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

RV PARKING – One person needs to be in charge and oversee the entire parking operation. If possible a pre-visit to the site is valuable for planning, checking out workable plug in's, water hookups and dump stations. After receiving general parking instructions from WASH-I-BAGOS officers:

- 1. Lay out specific sites as needed for handicapped section (placards must be displayed in window), vendors, dealers, officers & dignitaries etc.**
- 2. Allow for a Fire Lane/Emergency Entry/Exit of each coach when planning parking spots with enough width for a fire truck to get thru or a coach to leave by.**
- 3. Post appropriate signage on highway or intersections before coaches arrive.**
- 4. Move coaches off main roadway quickly then make space to allow them to unhook.**
- 5. Meeting, greeting, and parking all arrivals in a friendly, safe and professional way after completed documentation, are essential.**

Although most coaches arrive during the day, there needs to be a plan for parking latecomers. Standard is you arrive together to park together. No saving of spots for friends or chapter members. Visitors or guests are to be parked among parked rigs and not separated from others.

WASH-I-BAGOS will pay parking for up to four coaches required for setup and parking early arrivals for 1 night. Parkers should be prepared for bad weather, raingear etc. It is advised to plan for a cover shelter from weather conditions i.e. sun or rain. Radios for communications with officers are available. Golf carts possibly available at Moses Lake particularly.

At Lynden utilize gate 3 for entry into grounds. This makes it possible to get everyone off the highway and a place to unhook. Plus the regular tree lane gate entry is too low for RV rooflines with antennas etc.

A budget of \$50.00 is allowed for a welcome treat for attendees. Note: from NW07 Committee Reports: From the Dollar Store the San Juanderers found a 6-cookie package and ten packages to a box for \$1.00. There is a variety of flavors in each box. Each rally attendee received a package of cookies. A winner.
